INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR BUNKER OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 2001

Accession by Mongolia and Palau

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Civil Liability for Bunker Oil Pollution Damage, 2001, and to state that, in accordance with article 12, accession by Mongolia and the Republic of Palau was effected by the deposit of instruments on 28 September 2011.

The Convention will enter into force for Mongolia and Palau on 28 December 2011, in accordance with the provisions of article 14.

There are, at present, sixty-two Contracting States to the Convention, representing approximately 89.04% of the world's merchant shipping.
