**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR BUNKER OIL
POLLUTION DAMAGE, 2001**

Declaration by Cyprus

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the accession by the Republic of Cyprus to the International Convention on Civil Liability for Bunker Oil Pollution Damage, 2001, on 10 January 2005 (BUNKERS/Circ.4).

In this connection, the Secretary-General received, on 26 April 2005 the following declaration from Cyprus:

“Judgments on matters covered by the Convention shall, when given by a court in Austria, Belgium, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden or the United Kingdom, be recognised and enforced in the Republic of Cyprus according to the relevant internal Community rules on the subject (at present, these rules are laid down in Regulation (EC) No. 44/2001).”
