CONVENTION ON THE INTERNATIONAL REGULATIONS FOR PREVENTING COLLISIONS AT SEA, 1972, AS AMENDED

Accession by the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Convention on the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, 1972, as amended, and to state that, in accordance with article II, accession by the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya was effected by the deposit of an instrument on 28 April 2005.

The Convention entered into force for the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya on 28 April 2005, in accordance with article IV(3).

There are, at present, one hundred and forty-seven Contracting States to the Convention.
