INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE CONTROL OF HARMFUL ANTI-FOULING SYSTEMS ON SHIPS, 2001

Accession by Barbados

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on the Control of Harmful Anti-fouling Systems on Ships, 2001, and to state that, in accordance with article 17 of the Convention, accession by Barbados was effected by the deposit of an instrument on 30 January 2012.

The Convention will enter into force for Barbados on 30 April 2012, in accordance with the provisions of article 18(3).

There are, at present, fifty-eight Contracting States to the Convention, representing approximately 78.92%^{*} of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant shipping.

This tonnage percentage is based on world tonnage figures provided by IHS-Fairplay, effective as of 31 December 2010. Tonnage figures are liable to fluctuate from year to year.
