INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE CONTROL OF HARMFUL ANTI-FOULING SYSTEMS ON SHIPS, 2001

Accession by Kenya

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on the Control of Harmful Anti-fouling Systems on Ships, 2001 and to state that, in accordance with article 17 of the Convention, accession by the Republic of Kenya was effected by deposit of an instrument on 7 July 2015.

The Convention will enter into force for Kenya on 7 October 2015, in accordance with article 18(3) of the Convention.

There are, at present, 71 Contracting States to the Convention, representing approximately 84.86%* of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant shipping.
