INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE CONTROL OF HARMFUL ANTI-FOULING SYSTEMS ON SHIPS, 2001

Accession by Guyana

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on the Control of Harmful Anti-fouling Systems on Ships, 2001, and to state that, in accordance with article 17(3) of the Convention, accession by the Co-operative Republic of Guyana was effected by the deposit of an instrument on 20 February 2019.

The Convention will enter into force for Guyana on 20 May 2019, in accordance with article 18(3) of the Convention.

There are, at present, 84 Contracting States to the Convention, representing approximately 95.96%* of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant shipping.
