INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE CONTROL OF HARMFUL ANTI-FOULING SYSTEMS ON SHIPS, 2001

Accession by Malaysia

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on the Control of Harmful Anti-fouling Systems on Ships, 2001, and to state that, in accordance with article 17 of the Convention, accession by Malaysia was effected by the deposit of an instrument on 27 September 2010.

The Convention will enter into force for Malaysia on 27 December 2010, in accordance with the provisions of article 18(3).

There are, at present, forty-eight Contracting States to the Convention, representing approximately 75.27% of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant shipping.
