RELATIONS WITH THE HOST STATE

RESOLUTION C.16(XI) adopted on 27 May 1964

THE COUNCIL,

NOTES that the Secretary-General has communicated the text of Assembly Resolution A.56(III), concerning relations with the Host State, to the United Kingdom Government and that it has invited that Government to begin discussions with a view to concluding a supplemental agreement in which the Organization's privileges, facilities and immunities and measures for implementing them will be formulated in detail.

FURTHER NOTES that the Secretary-General will report the results of the discussions to the twelfth session of the Council and will, if possible, present at that session a draft agreement for Council approval as envisaged by the Resolution.
