According to the item 2 of the Article IV of the International Convention on Safe Containers (1972) Administration which entrusts testing, inspecting and approval of containers to organization shall inform the Secretary-General about it.

Considering the mentioned above, I would like to inform you that 12.04.2012 the Agreement between the Ministry of Infrastructure of Ukraine and the State Enterprise "Classification Society the Shipping Register of Ukraine" on Delegation of Conventional Services for Ships, Offshore Drilling Units and other Floating Constructions flying the flag of Ukraine was concluded. According to this Agreement the Shipping Register of Ukraine is authorized to perform testing, inspecting and approval of containers of all types.
