**PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON
CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

Accession by South Africa, Saint Kitts and Nevis and Israel

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12, accession by the following Contracting States was effected by deposit of instruments on the dates indicated:

	Date of deposit of instrument	Date of entry into force
Republic of South Africa	1 October 2004	1 October 2005
Saint Kitts and Nevis	7 October 2004	7 October 2005
State of Israel	21 October 2004	21 October 2005

There are, at present, one hundred and four Contracting States to the Protocol.
