PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969

Accession by the United Republic of Tanzania and Namibia

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that accession by the United Republic of Tanzania and the Republic of Namibia was effected by deposit of instruments on 19 November 2002 and 18 December 2002, respectively, in accordance with article 12.

The Protocol will enter into force for the United Republic of Tanzania on 19 November 2003 and for Namibia on 18 December 2003, respectively, in accordance with the provisions of article 13 of the Protocol.

There are, at present, ninety Contracting States to the Protocol.
