**PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON
CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

Accession by Pakistan, Lebanon, Maldives and Saudi Arabia

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12, accession by the following States was effected by the deposit of instruments on the dates indicated:

Islamic Republic of Pakistan	2 March 2005	2 March 2006
Lebanese Republic	30 March 2005	30 March 2006
Republic of Maldives	20 May 2005	20 May 2006
Kingdom of Saudi Arabia	23 May 2005	23 May 2006

There are, at present, one hundred and nine Contracting States to the Protocol.
