PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969

Accession by Serbia

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12, accession by the Republic of Serbia was effected by the deposit of an instrument on 25 May 2011.

In accordance with the provisions of article 13, the Protocol will enter into force for Serbia on 25 May 2012.

There are, at present, one hundred and twenty-four States Parties to the Protocol, representing approximately 96.62% of the gross tonnage of the world's merchant shipping.
