PROTOCOL OF 1976 TO THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969

Accession by Cambodia and El Salvador

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1976 to the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that accession by the Kingdom of Cambodia and the Republic of El Salvador was effected by the deposit of instruments on 8 June 2001 and 2 January 2002, respectively, in accordance with article IV(1).

The Protocol will enter into force for Cambodia on 6 September 2001 and El Salvador on 2 April 2002, respectively, in accordance with the provisions of article V of the Protocol.

There are, at present, fifty-five Contracting States to the Protocol.
