**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR  
OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

**Denunciation by Yemen**

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to article XVI of the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, by the terms of which a Contracting State may denounce the Convention at any time after its entry into force for that State, by depositing an instrument with the Secretary-General of the Organization.

The Secretary-General has the honour to state that denunciation by the Republic of Yemen was effected by deposit of an instrument on 31 July 2008, in accordance with article XVI, paragraph 2.

In accordance with article XVI, paragraph 3, the denunciation will take effect for Yemen on 31 July 2009.
