**PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON
CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

Accession by the Dominican Republic, Indonesia and Seychelles

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12 accession by the Dominican Republic, the Republic of Indonesia and the Republic of Seychelles was effected by deposit of instruments on the dates indicated:

	Date of deposit of instrument	Date of entry into force
Dominican Republic	24 June 1999	24 June 2000
Indonesia	6 July 1999	6 July 2000
Seychelles	23 July 1999	23 July 1999

There are, at present, forty-eight Contracting States to the Protocol.
