**PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON  
CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

**Accession by Dominica, Angola, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines,  
Cameroon, Portugal, Colombia and Qatar**

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12 accession by the following Contracting States was effected by the deposit of instruments on the dates indicated:
