**PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON
CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

Accession by Madagascar, Nigeria, Chile and Gabon

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12, accession by the following Contracting States was effected by the deposit of instruments on the dates indicated:

Republic of Madagascar	21 May 2002	21 May 2003
Federal Republic of Nigeria	24 May 2002	24 May 2003
Republic of Chile	29 May 2002	29 May 2003
Gabonese Republic	31 May 2002	31 May 2003

There are, at present, eighty-six Contracting States to the Protocol.
