INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969

Accession by Jordan

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that accession by the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan was effected by deposit of an instrument on 14 October 2003, in accordance with article XIII.

The Convention will enter into force for Jordan on 12 January 2004, in accordance with the provisions of article XV of the Convention.
