**PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON  
CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

**Accession by Ukraine, Ecuador and Mongolia**

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12, accession by the following Contracting States was effected by the deposit of instrument on the dates indicated:

Ukraine	29 November 2007	29 November 2008
The Republic of Ecuador	11 December 2007	11 December 2008
Mongolia	8 August 2008	8 August 2009

In accordance with the provisions of article 13 of the Protocol, it will enter into force for these States on the dates indicated above.

There are, at present, one hundred and twenty-one Contracting States to the Protocol.
