**PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON
CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

Accession by El Salvador, Brunei Darussalam and Samoa

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12 accession by the following Contracting States was effected by the deposit of instruments on the dates indicated:

| Brunei Darussalam | 31 January 2002 | 31 January 2003 |
| Independent State of Samoa | 1 February 2002 | 1 February 2003 |

There are, at present, eighty-one Contracting States to the Protocol.
