**PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON
CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

**Accession by Peru, Moldova, Luxembourg, Yemen, Kiribati,
Cook Islands and Hungary**

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12, accession by the following Contracting States was effected by the deposit of instrument on the dates indicated:

The Grand Duchy of Luxembourg	21 November 2005	21 November 2006
The Republic of Yemen	20 September 2006	20 September 2007
Kiribati	5 February 2007	5 February 2008
The Cook Islands	12 March 2007	12 March 2008
The Republic of Hungary	30 March 2007	30 March 2008

In accordance with the provisions of article 13 of the Protocol, it has, or will, enter into force for these States on the dates indicated above.

There are, at present, one hundred and seventeen Contracting States to the Protocol.
