PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969

Accession by Viet Nam and Cape Verde

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that accession by the Socialist Republic of Vietnam and the Republic of Cape Verde was effected by deposit of instruments on 17 June 2003 and 4 July 2003, respectively, in accordance with article 12.

The Protocol will enter into force for Viet Nam and Cape Verde on 17 June 2004 and 4 July 2004, respectively, in accordance with the provisions of article 13 of the Protocol.

There are, at present, ninety-three Contracting States to the Protocol.
