PROTOCOL [OF 1976] TO THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969

Denunciation by Colombia

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to article VI of the Protocol [of 1976] to the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, by the terms of which any Party may denounce the Protocol at any time after its entry into force for that Party, by depositing an instrument with the Secretary-General of the Organization.

The Secretary-General has the honour to state that denunciation by the Republic of Colombia was effected by deposit of an instrument on 25 January 2005, in accordance with article VI.

In accordance with article VI, paragraph 3, the denunciation will take effect for Colombia on 25 January 2006.
