**PROTOCOL OF 1992 TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON
CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1969**

Accession by Antigua and Barbuda, Lithuania and Slovenia

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 12 accession by the following Contracting States was effected by deposit of instruments on the dates indicated:

	Date of deposit of instrument	Date of entry into force
Antigua and Barbuda	14 June 2000	14 June 2001
Republic of Lithuania	27 June 2000	27 June 2001
Republic of Slovenia	19 July 2000	19 July 2001

There are, at present, sixty-three Contracting States to the Protocol.
