INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE

Accession by Guyana

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that accession by the Republic of Guyana was effected by the deposit of an instrument on 10 December 1997, in accordance with article XIII.

The Convention will enter into force for Guyana on 10 March 1998, in accordance with the provisions of article XV of the Convention.

There are, at present, one hundred Contracting States to the Convention.
