APPORTIONMENT OF EXPENSES AMONG MEMBER STATES

THE ASSEMBLY,

RECALLING resolution A.76(IV) in which the scale of apportionment of annual expenses among Members and Associate Members was adopted,

RECALLING ALSO its decisions to establish a Working Group on the Assessment of IMO Contributions at its eleventh session and to reconvene the Working Group at its twelfth session,

NOTING that the Working Group has unanimously agreed on a new system of assessment,

NOTING FURTHER that the proposed new system also achieved unanimous agreement in the Council.

1. RESOLVES that from 1 January 1984 the scale of apportionment of annual expenses among Members and Associate Members shall be based on the following principles:

Each Member and Associate Member shall be required to contribute:

(a) a basic assessment in accordance with the following table:

The value of a basic unit shall be determined by dividing 10% of the total budget assessment for the relevant financial year by the total number of basic units for all Members and Associate Members;

(b) An additional assessment determined by its gross register tonnage as shown in the latest edition of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, less 50,000 tons, on the basis of one share for each 1,000 tons. Each Associate Member shall be required to contribute an additional assessment determined by one half of its gross register tonnage, less 50,000 tons, on the basis of one share for each 1,000 tons.
