RESOLUTION A.103(IV)

AGREEMENT BETWEEN FAO AND IMCO

THE ASSEMBLY,

RECALLING Part XII of the IMCO Convention entitled "Relationship with the United Nations and other Organizations",

RECALLING FURTHER that Article 26 provides that the Council may enter into agreements covering relationships with other organizations and should submit such agreements to the Assembly for approval,

HAVING CONSIDERED the text of an Agreement between the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations and the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization adopted by the Council at its fourteenth session,

APPROVES the Agreement, the text of which is annexed to this Resolution,

UNDERSTANDS that the text will be considered by the next Conference of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations,

INVITES the Secretary-General to submit to the Council proposals concerning the establishment of joint committees pursuant to Article III of the Agreement,

FURTHER INVITES the Secretary-General to communicate the text of this Resolution to the Director-General of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations.

ANNEX

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANIZATION OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE INTER-GOVERNMENTAL MARITIME CONSULTATIVE ORGANIZATION

Whereas the Constitution of the Food and Agriculture Organization (hereinafter referred to as FAO) provides that the Organization may enter into agreements with other international organizations with related activities in order to define methods of co-operation; and

Whereas the Convention on the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization (hereinafter referred to as IMCO) provides that the Organization shall co-operate with any specialized agency of the United Nations in matters which may be the common concern of the Organization and of such specialized agency, and shall consider such matters and act with respect to them in accord with such specialized agency;

FAO and IMCO agree as follows:
