**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION RELATING TO INTERVENTION ON
THE HIGH SEAS IN CASES OF OIL POLLUTION CASUALTIES, 1969**

Accession by Trinidad and Tobago

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention relating to Intervention on the High Seas in Cases of Oil Pollution Casualties, done at Brussels on 29 November 1969, and to state that accession by the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago was effected by deposit of an instrument on 6 March 2000, in accordance with article IX of the Convention.

In accordance with article XI, the Convention will enter into force for Trinidad and Tobago on 4 June 2000, ninety days after the deposit of the instrument.

There are, at present, seventy-four Contracting States to the Convention.
