**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION RELATING TO INTERVENTION ON
THE HIGH SEAS IN CASES OF OIL POLLUTION CASUALTIES**

Accession by Saint Vincent and the Grenadines

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention relating to Intervention on the High Seas in Cases of Oil Pollution Casualties, done at Brussels on 29 November 1969, and to state that accession by Saint Vincent and the Grenadines was effected by deposit of an instrument on 12 May 1999, in accordance with article IX of the Convention.

In accordance with article XI, the Convention will enter into force for Saint Vincent and the Grenadines on 10 August 1999, ninety days after the deposit of the instrument.

There are, at present, seventy-three Contracting States to the Convention.
