**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION RELATING TO INTERVENTION ON
THE HIGH SEAS IN CASES OF OIL POLLUTION CASUALTIES, 1969**

Accession by Saint Kitts and Nevis

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention relating to Intervention on the High Seas in Cases of Oil Pollution Casualties, done at Brussels on 29 November 1969, and to state that accession by Saint Kitts and Nevis was effected by deposit of an instrument on 7 October 2004, in accordance with article IX of the Convention.

In accordance with article XI, the Convention will enter into force for Saint Kitts and Nevis on 5 January 2005, ninety days after the deposit of the instrument.

There are, at present, eighty-two Contracting States to the Convention.
