**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION RELATING TO INTERVENTION ON
THE HIGH SEAS IN CASES OF OIL POLLUTION CASUALTIES, 1969**

Accession by India

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention relating to Intervention on the High Seas in Cases of Oil Pollution Casualties, done at Brussels on 29 November 1969, and to state that accession by the Republic of India was effected by deposit of an instrument on 16 June 2000, in accordance with article IX of the Convention.

In accordance with article XI, the Convention will enter into force for India on 14 September 2000, ninety days after the deposit of the instrument.

There are, at present, seventy-five Contracting States to the Convention.
