INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION RELATING TO INTERVENTION ON THE HIGH SEAS IN CASES OF OIL POLLUTION CASUALTIES, 1969

Accession by Mauritius

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention relating to Intervention on the High Seas in Cases of Oil Pollution Casualties, done at Brussels on 29 November 1969, and to state that accession by the Republic of Mauritius was effected by deposit of an instrument on 17 December 2002, in accordance with article IX of the Convention.

In accordance with article XI, the Convention will enter into force for Mauritius on 17 March 2003, ninety days after the deposit of the instrument.

There are, at present, seventy-eight Contracting States to the Convention.
